

# **SARAN WRAP GAME RULES**

The directions and rules for the saran wrap ball game are very simple. You will need to have the group of players sit in a circle. The starting player of the round will have the ball on his or her lap. The player sitting next to the player with the ball on the left will roll a dice set until they get doubles. After the player lands on doubles with the dice, they yell, "DOUBLES," and receive the ball.

In the meantime, whatever the player unwrapping the ball drops out. He or she gets to keep for a prize.

The rule is if the prize is completely unrolled from the Saran Wrap ball, then the winner will keep it. If it is still stuck, they will unfortunately not get to keep that item even if it's only stuck a little bit. It will be the next player's turn to try and win it.

The ball will continue to move to the next person on the left until everyone has had a turn or all prizes are unrolled claimed.

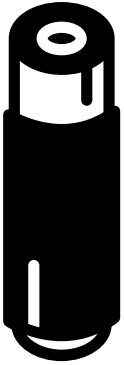
1. Cash

Good prizes for kids to collect would be party favors, trinkets, novelty items, and candy. The best prizes my kiddos love getting in their game ball are the following items.

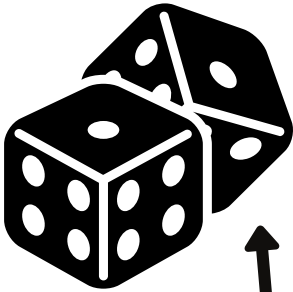
1. Stickers

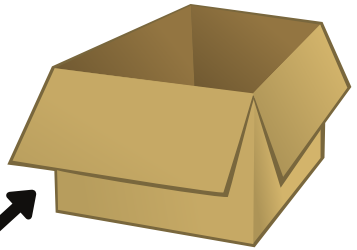
